- File Form 990-PF annually
- Maintain an investment committee, written policy statement, and governance structure
- Distribute 5% of assets each year—e.g., \$50,000 annually on a \$1 million foundation balance—or face excise tax penalties

Many families find that the overhead, compliance risk, and administrative requirements of a private foundation can distract from their deeper philanthropic goals.
